

Housing Ministry launches Nurturing Neighbourhoods Challenge

Chennai, Nov 6: The Smart Cities Mission, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, held a kick-off event for the 'Nurturing Neighbourhoods Challenge' in collaboration with the Netherlands-based Bernard van Leer Foundation (BvLF) and with the technical support of WRI India. By focusing on the needs of young children
